Coronavirus Supplemental Scholarship

THE SCHOLARSHIP

Through the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act, the **Coronavirus Supplemental Scholarship** awards one thousand dollars (\$1,000) to all High School, Home Education or Home School, Adult Education, and General Education Development (GED) graduates of the Spring of 2020 and the Spring of 2021, who are permanent residents of the VI and resided in the Territory at the time of graduation and have been accepted into or are attending a college, university, or other post-secondary education, third-level tertiary education, or advanced vocational or trade school.

WHO CAN APPLY

- Graduates of the Class of 2021
- Graduates of the Class of 2020 who did not receive a Coronavirus scholarship last year
- Graduates of the Class of 2020 who received a Coronavirus scholarship last year, once they are currently enrolled in a college, university or trade school

New applicants

- Complete a V.I. Board of Education application online
- Submit a letter indicating how the graduate has been affected by the pandemic
- Submit proof of graduation from a V.I. high school, Home Education or Home School, Adult Education, or GED program
- Submit an acceptance letter

Returning applicants

- Complete a V.I. Board of Education application online
- Submit a letter indicating how the graduate has been affected by the Pandemic
- Submit an official transcript

NOTE: If applicant fails to complete his/her first semester, the funds must be returned to the Government of the U.S. Virgin Islands.
